GOD PROVIDES AND CONNECTS - Psalm 104:10-14

Lord, you make springs pour water into the ravines; they flow between the mountains. They give water to all the beasts of the field; the wild donkeys quench their thirst. The birds of the air nest by the waters; they sing among the branches. You water the mountains from your lofty abode; the earth is satisfied by the fruit of your work. 
