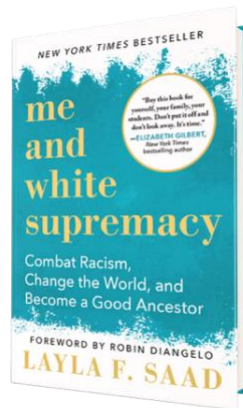

Unlike many of our adult education offerings, this series is not primarily an academic pursuit—this book will ask you to explore your inner world, and in doing so, you will be both challenged and transformed.

You do **not** need to attend every session to participate, *but you do need to complete the reading and journaling every week, even if you are away!* This way, the group can learn and grow together.
