Why do we have four Gospels? Why do they contradict each other at times? What is the Book of Revelation really about? This fall, we’re continuing our year-long look at the New Testament with the Great Courses video lecture series. We’ll begin with a review of the gospels we covered last spring (Mark, Matthew, Luke) and then move on to the Gospel of John, the letters NOT written by Paul, and the Book of Revelation. We’ll examine the original contexts of these books and the people who wrote them, giving us a new perspective on these ancient writings.

We’ll watch the video together as a group and then have a discussion facilitated by Pastor Maureen. The class will meet every 1st and 3rd Wednesday at 10:00 a.m. from September through May. We’ll meet on Zoom because we’ve found this to be a more inclusive way to be together! All are welcome!
