

The Mission of Home Starter



Our mission is to collect furniture and household goods to assist those in need who are transitioning into independent living.

We have helped single mothers coming from abusive relationships or rehab, young people getting their first place after being homeless, and entire families that had been living in their car.

Running Home Starter

- Home Starter began in 2019 as an initiative of the World Service Committee of the Congregational Church of Amherst, New Hampshire, United Church of Christ
- All work is provided by church volunteers and interested community members
- All furniture is donated by our neighbors
- Kitchen kits and bathroom kits are put together with purchased and donated items, for which we conduct periodic collection drives

Kitchen Kits

Each kitchen kit includes essential items like these:

- Pots and skillets with lids
- Glass baking dish
- Plastic mixing bowls
- Knives, vegetable peeler
- Manual can opener
- Silicone spatulas, tongs
- Rimmed baking/cookie sheet
- Colander

- Spoons, measuring cups
- Utensils and flatware
- Toaster
- Dish towels, oven mitts
- Dish soap, sponges
- Broom and dustpan
- Garbage can & bags
- Dishes


Bathroom Kits

Each bathroom kit includes essential items like these:

- Bath towel set (2)
- Bathmat
- Drain cover
- Soap dispenser
- Shower curtain, liner, and hooks
- Toilet plunger and brush

- Trash can
- Toilet paper and tissues
- Bathroom cleaner
- Toilet cleaner
- First aid kit
- Small basic toolkit

Home Starter Trailer




Our purchase of a trailer for moving furniture was made possible by a generous bequest to the church.

- A young mother, referred to us by the Nashua Soup Kitchen and Shelter, needed bedroom furniture, including a bed for herself, as well as equipment for her baby.
- A grandmother raising 3 grandchildren needed assistance to furnish the house she had just moved into. Before this, they were living in a shelter. We furnished the entire house.



Challenges

- Our greatest challenges are recruiting volunteers to transport items and the cost of storage space.
- We began with one or two referrals per month, then 4 or 5, and it has grown from there.
- In 2023, we served over 50 families in need.
- We had to find more furniture storage space. We are now using two rented storage units and a portable storage unit.



Pickups and Deliveries

- We maintain a rotating list of volunteers who have offered to help us with pickups and deliveries.

Donate Furniture and Household Items

We need furniture and household items in good condition

- Small kitchen and dining room tables and chairs
- Lamps
- Side/end tables
- Small couches/sofas (no large couches or sleepers please)
- Loveseats
- Clean beds (no kings please)

- Chest drawers (no triple dressers)
- Microwave ovens
- Flat panel TVs in working order
- Clean, gently used bed linens
- Clean flatware and cookware in working order
- Essential bathroom supplies
