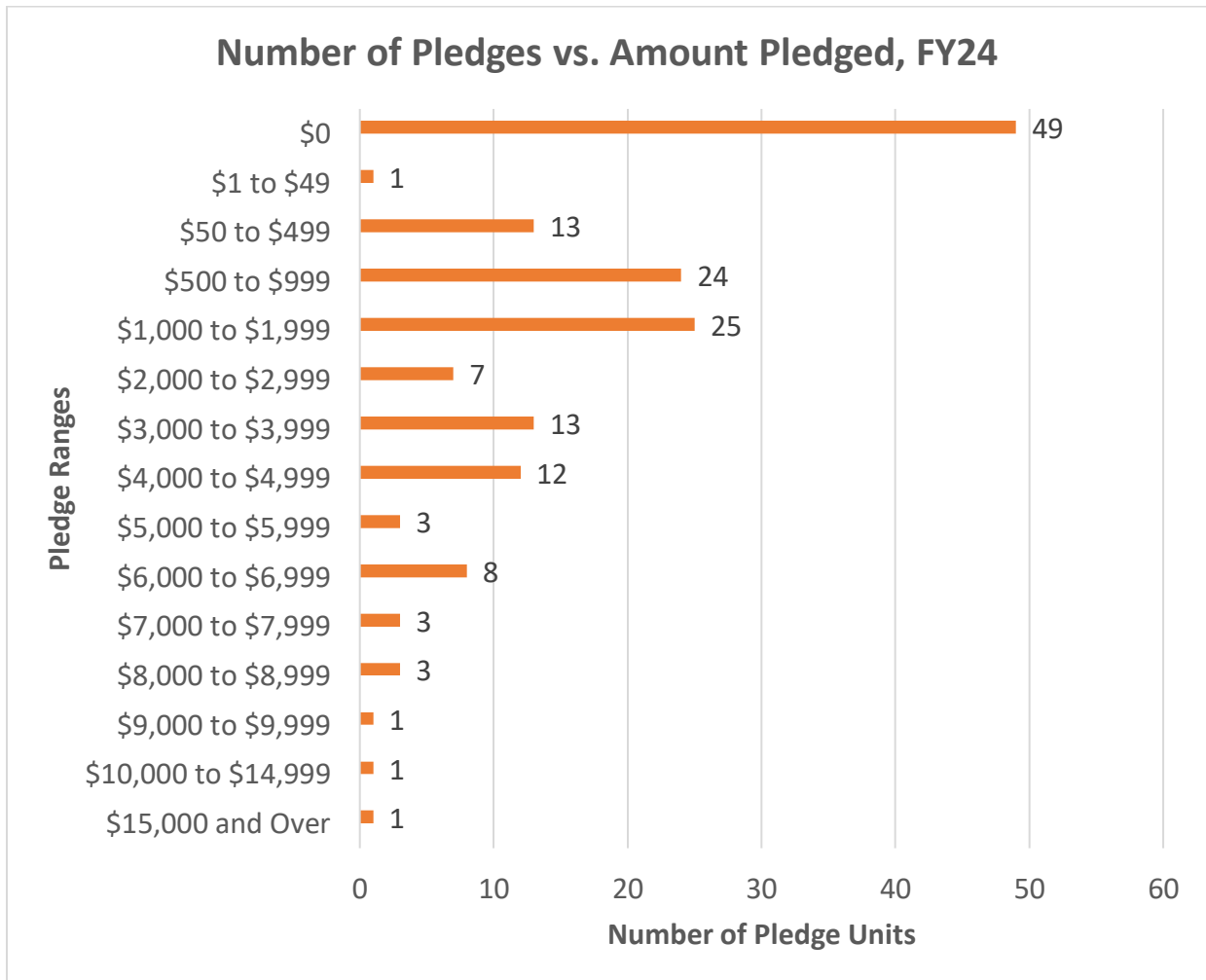


Where Do I Stand?

The chart below shows the range or tiers of pledge amounts and how many pledges are in each of those tiers for the recent fiscal year. Unfortunately, as you can see, the largest pledge tier is \$0 (i.e., NO PLEDGE). With 115 total pledges received, the top 20 givers accounted for over 47% of the total amount pledged (\$153K of \$329.4K total) The top 35 givers at or above the \$3,000 pledge tiers, accounted for 75% (\$246K) of the total amount pledged. Given that not all of us are able to support the church at these high levels, each and every pledge is still very important, appreciated, and contributes to the total income of the church. Where do you stand in these giving tiers? Can you possibly do more for this upcoming new fiscal year?



While you consider you pledge amount, some perspective on the church's rate of spending might be helpful. Given our proposed budget for FY25, the church spends nearly **\$1,000 each and every day** in pledge income to meet our basic obligations and missions. A \$1,000 pledge, although generous, covers but **one day** in the life of the church. Can you "sponsor" a day, two days, a week, or longer?
